
## How to Correctly Repair a Ball Mark on a Green

# **CORRECT**

- 1. Discard the loose piece of turf taken out by the ball.
- 2. Insert the repair tool just outside the back of the ball mark.
- 3. Pull the turf toward the center of the hole and repeat from other sides of mark.



- 4. When completed the ball mark area should be **completely green** with grass, not brown with soil
- 5. Gently pat down the repaired turf over the ball mark, providing almost instant recovery.

### **BEFORE**




### **AFTER**



# **INCORRECT**

- 1. Do not replace the loose piece of turf taken out by the ball
- 2. Do not pry up the center of the depression with the repair tool as it exposes the soil, damages the root system, and will delay the healing process.
- 3. Do not insert the repair tool and twist it. This will also damage the root system.
